## BRUNA GRIMALDI Barbera d'Alba Superiore Scassa 2013

POINTS: 84

A touch of new oak lends spice to the black cherry and boysenberry flavors in this red, which is lifted by bracing acidity and light tannins. Crisp finish. Drink now through 2018. 2,000 cases made. (BS)

## BRUNA GRIMALDI Dolcetto d'Alba San Martino 2013

POINTS: 87

Rich, bordering on meaty, this displays black cherry, earth, leather and black pepper notes, matched to a dense texture. Firm, ripe tannins show on the finish. Drink now through 2018. 1,000 cases made. (BS)

## BRUNA GRIMALDI Nebbiolo d'Alba 2013

POINTS: 87

A straightforward red delivering cherry, berry and licorice flavors, with moderate tannins that pile up slightly on the finish. Try with risotto or with pasta and tomato sauce. Drink now through 2020. 400 cases imported. (BS)

## BRUNA GRIMALDI Barbera d'Alba Superiore Scassa 2012

POINTS: 88

A rich, polished style, this red is stitched with black cherry, blackberry and leather flavors. Shows some grip on the lingering finish. Drink now through 2018. 450 cases imported. (BS)

## BRUNA GRIMALDI Barolo Badarina 2012

POINTS: 91

This red seems to be developing, from the fading cherry and berry fruit to the leafy, underbrush notes. Still, this shows sweetness and a firm underpinning of iron, acidity and tannins that imparts length and dynamics on the finish. Best from 2019 through 2033. 750 cases made. (BS)

## BRUNA GRIMALDI Barolo Bricco Ambrogio 2012

POINTS: 89

Licorice, menthol and earth aromas and flavors are the main themes in this sinewy red. Dense, dusty tannins coat the palate on the moderate finish. Best from 2019 through 2029. 500 cases made. (BS)

**BRUNA GRIMALDI Barolo Camilla 2012**

**POINTS: 90**

A racy, sinewy style, exhibiting cherry, licorice, eucalyptus and iron, backed by a wall of massive, mouthcoating tannins. Offers freshness and resonance on the finish. Best from 2020 through 2035. 1,000 cases made. (BS)

**BRUNA GRIMALDI Nebbiolo d'Alba Briccola 2012**

**POINTS: 87**

Licorice and cherry notes are the core flavors in this lean red, with accents of herbs. It's juicy, tightening up on the moderately long finish. Best from 2016 through 2021. 1,200 cases made. (BS)
